Pastor Scott's Scripts:

"This is a sad moment right here for all of us. And there ain't nothing I can say, standing in front of you that can take that away...But please do me this favor, will you? Lift your heads up and look around this locker room, yeah? Look at everybody else in here. And I want you to be grateful that you're going through this sad moment with all these other folks. Because I promise you, there is something worse out there than being sad and that is being alone and being sad. Ain't nobody in this room alone. Let's be sad now. Let's be sad together."

In this scene, Coach Lasso tries to get his team out of being sad before he recognizes that sadness is part of being human. He then leans into the sadness and gives them permission to feel...reminding them that their sadness is being shared with others. This scene reminds me of what we in the church should aspire to. Everybody will confront sadness. It's just a reality of living. But as a church family, we do sadness together. We do worry together. We do grief together because in this church, we aspire to be a family where no one is ever alone.

With that being said, please contact the church when you are feeling sad...when you're struggling...I and others in our church are eager to share our time with you...eager to share our connection with you.

On Sunday, September 8th during our outdoor worship, we as a church family are going to celebrate the unsung heroes in our lives who forever remind us that we are never alone. We are going to share "The Blessing of our Pets" as well as share a moment of silence for our beloved pets who still live lovingly in our memory.

Life is full of unique connections that help us cope with our sadness. Our pets are some of God's greatest gifts who do just that. They deserve a blessing and our gratitude.

See ya in church...the place where we can be sad, but never alone.



Music will be back in full swing. We will once again be singing on the 3rd Sunday of each month at the 10:00 service.




