Not only did Colin live his dash, our connection reminded me why I coach and he helped me understand my purpose as a coach. In essence, our connection reminded me of the ministry I was doing on the golf course.

All in all, it was quite the day. I want to thank all of you for your support and understanding during the golf season. It takes the sacrifice of many for me to coach and to minister. But as May 19th proved, it is worth the effort because God is served and God is present in all kinds of ways.

Before we conclude that the kids of today are simply self-centered and glued to their phones, I have experienced young people working hard, showing great character sharing such gracious and loving understanding. There are wonderful young people in this world and I want to thank you for the privilege of being a part of their journey.
