I believe Mister Rogers said it best, "I believe that appreciation is a holy thing. So in loving and appreciating our neighbor, we're participating in something sacred."



2026 Giving Envelopes Available Soon!

2026 offering envelopes will be available in the Narthex. You will find several "extra" envelopes along with your weekly offering envelopes to make your giving easy.

- Initial Offering Envelope: Helps defray the cost of the box of envelopes. Suggested contribution is \$5.00.
- Blue Per Capita Apportionment Envelope: Per Capita is "the tie that binds" annual giving that unites the entire church in the ongoing and essential work that guides the Office of the General Assembly, the life of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and benefits every congregation and every mid council ministry. Per capita is the primary source of funding for the office of the General Assembly, and is how Presbyterians mutually and equitably share the costs of coming together to discern the Spirit's leading for the future. The Per Capita amount for North Presbyterian confirmed, active members for 2025 was \$40.00. It has not yet been shared what the 2026 amount will be. We will share that as soon as it becomes available.
- Pink Building Fund Envelope: Helps offset our building and maintenance costs.
- Blue and White "One Great Hour of Sharing" Envelope: This offering
 is collected throughout Lent and supports the following causes:
 Disaster, hunger, poverty, climate change, immigration, migration and
 refugees.
- Purple "Christmas Joy Offering" Envelope: Advent offering that supports the following causes: Children-at-risk, youth & young adults, leadership development for people of color, Presbyterian-related schools and colleges equipping communities of color, servants of the church in need.

Online giving also includes these offering opportunities. If you are not currently utilizing the online giving option, please consider doing so. It is easy to do and assists in making our financials run smoothly.
